



**The Italian Chapter of IEEE Magnetics Society wants to reward scientific activity performed by young researchers in the field of magnetism.**

**With this aim, the Chapter presents, for the ninth year, an award addressed to a researcher who has published outstanding research about magnetism and related topics in the last years on IEEE Journals.**

**Application process and requirements for 2024 award:**

- Deadline for application is the 20<sup>th</sup> of November 2024.
- Applicants should be Members of the IEEE Italy Section and of the IEEE Magnetics Society.
- Applicants should be no older than 40 years old on the 20<sup>th</sup> of November 2024.
- Applicants should be under-graduate students, PhD students, post-docs or young researchers not in a permanent position.
- Application must be sent via e-mail to the Chair of the IEEE Magnetics Society – Italy Chapter prof. Vito Puliafito ([vito.puliafito@poliba.it](mailto:vito.puliafito@poliba.it)), and, in cc, to the secretary of the Chapter prof. Anna Giordano ([anna.giordano@unime.it](mailto:anna.giordano@unime.it)).
- The application must include a detailed CV, including date of birth and information about IEEE membership, and a scientific paper. The paper should be an original research work in the field of magnetism which has been already published on an IEEE Journal during the years 2021-2024.
- The Commission which will select the 2024 award winner is composed by Jia Yan Law (University of Seville, Spain), Pedram Khalili Amiri (Northwestern University, USA), and Davide Bossini (University of Konstanz, Germany). The Commission will evaluate the applicants, based on a set of criteria, including the relevance of the work and its scientific impact.
- Results of the selection will be announced by the end of November.
- The award will consist of €500, and a plaque addressed to the researcher. The winner researcher will also have the opportunity to give a talk about the submitted paper at one of the events organized by the Chapter.
