



“IEEE Sensors Journal” Best Student Paper Award Rules for Participants

The IEEE Sensors Council Italy Chapter recognizes distinguished papers authored by young researchers in the field of Sensors design, fabrication, characterization, and applications through the presentation of an Award for the “Best student paper” published on IEEE Sensors Journal. The Award consists in an honorarium of 100 Euro and a Certificate.

One award will be presented with reference to papers published in past issues (2018 and 2019) of IEEE Sensors Journal.

Only candidates with the following requisites are eligible for the award:

- be a Student Member of the IEEE Italy Section at the time the paper was submitted;
- be one of the authors of the article;
- no application to the previous edition of the Award.

Candidates must send their application by December 31, 2019, together with:

- self-certification of IEEE Student membership;
- an electronic copy of the published paper in pdf format;
- Curriculum Vitae including educational background, positions held, publications, awards, etc.
