

IEEE –Italy Sensors Chapter Best Student Paper Award at the 2023 IEEE International Workshop Biomedical Applications, Technologies and Sensors

Rules for Participants

The IEEE Italy Sensors Chapter recognizes young researchers through the presentation of two Best Student Paper Awards at the "Biomedical Applications, Technologies and Sensors". These awards will be given to two distinguished papers authored by students and accepted to the 2023 IEEE International Workshop on Biomedical Applications, Technologies and Sensors to be held in Catanzaro (Italy), September 28-29, 2023.

The awards consist of a certificate and a prize of 100,00 Euro each.

To be eligible for the Best Student Paper Award, the applicant must be:

- a Student Member of IEEE at the time the paper was submitted to the workshop
- one of the authors of the accepted paper
- the presenting author of the paper at the 2023 IEEE International Workshop on Biomedical Applications, Technologies and Sensors

Judgment criteria for the two Best Student Paper Awards will be based on the scientific content of the paper and on the presentation of the work at the workshop.

The evaluation committee consists of two members of the IEEE Italy Sensors Chapter nominated by the Chapter Chair and two members of the Organizing Committee of the *Biomedical Applications*, *Technologies and Sensors* workshop.

The winners will be notified during the closing ceremony of the workshop. All the decisions of the Board are final. No ex-aequo is allowed.
